



Dear Student:

If you have not taken an ACT or SAT and you are planning to attend West Virginia State University, you may register for the Residual ACT. This test will be given in Wallace Hall on the following date:

Tuesday, December 12, 2017 (1:00 pm – 5:00 pm)

Deadline to register: December 5, 2017 (4:00 pm)

Wednesday, January 3, 2018 (1:00 pm– 5:00 pm)

Deadline to register: December 19, 2017 (4:00 pm)

Tuesday, January 9, 2018 (9:00 am-1:00 pm)

Deadline to register: January 4, 2018 (4:00 pm)

Register for this date using the attached form. Complete the form and return it along with the test fee of **\$46.00** in the form of a check or money order (**No Cash**) payable to West Virginia State University. Use the return address listed on the registration form.

Please note that admission to WVSU requires a composite score of 18 or above on the ACT exam.

On the day of the exam, room assignments will be posted at the entrance doors of **Wallace Hall** and the testing rooms. Bring with you **three sharpened soft lead (#2) pencils with erasers**. Also, bring **positive, non-expired photo bearing ID**, such as your driver's license or school ID. *You will not be allowed to test without proper identification.*

You will not be permitted to take textbooks, foreign language or other dictionaries, notes, or other aids such as "Smart" phones into the examination room. All phones must be **turned off** for entire session (including break). Calculators are permitted for the math section. You are not permitted to use a built-in calculator on any hand held device (e.g. Smart phones). **Calculators with built-in algebra systems are prohibited!** Calculators in this group include all calculators in all of the following series:

Casio: CFX-9970G (all models), Algebra fx2.0, ClassPad 300 and ClassPad 330, ClassPad 400(fx-CP400)

Texas Instruments: TI-89 (all models) and TI-92 (all models), and the TI-Nspire CAS

Hewlett-Packard: HP-40G, HP-49G and HP-50G (all models), and HP-48GII, HP Prime

Please be advised that effective with the 1989-90 administration of the Enhanced ACT Assessment, residual test results will be reported **ONLY** to the college administering the test. As in the past, **no Student Reports or High School Reports will be generated**. In addition, **no Additional Score Reports (ASR's) will be generated to report scores to any other institutions**.
