2018-2019 Program Review Report

In 2018-2019, nine programs are up for full review: B.A. in International Studies, Regents Bachelor of Arts, B.S. in Criminal Justice, M.S. in Criminal Justice Administration, B.A. in Art, B.F.A. in Music Performance, B.S. in Social Work, B.S. in Sports Studies and B.S. in Health Science. For International Studies, the committee has recommended increased institutional commitment to develop the program. For RBA, the committee recommended continuation at the current level with a follow-up report on assessment. These programs were by the Board of Governors in December 2018. For the B.S. in Criminal Justice, the committee recommended continuation at the current level with a follow-up report on assessment. For the M.S. in Criminal Justice Administration, the committee has recommended increased institutional commitment to develop the program. These programs are scheduled to be reviewed by the Board of Governors in February 2019. The committee has yet to consider Art and Music, which are scheduled to be reviewed by the Board of Governors in April 2019 and Sports Studies, Health Science and Social Work, which are scheduled to be reviewed by the Board of Governors in May 2019.

Programs scheduled for full review next year are: Communications, Media Studies, English, Biology and Biotechnology.

An election for Program Review will need to be held at the May General Faculty meeting to replace an outgoing, term-limited member of the committee.
