Position Description

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at West Virginia State University invites applications for a full-time Instructor of Mathematics position starting Fall 2022. This position is renewable annually depending on teaching performance and institutional need.

Responsibilities include teaching elementary mathematics and mathematics education courses and participation in department and university committees. Normal teaching load is 15 credit hours per semester. Ability to teach elementary computer science classes is a plus. The successful candidate is expected to have teaching experience at secondary and post-secondary levels. Successful candidate will need to complete a background check.

A Master's degree in Mathematics or a related field is required with a strong commitment to teaching undergraduates.

Salary Statement

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Appointment Status

This is a 9-month, full-time, benefit-eligible, instructor position.

Proposed Starting Date

The anticipated start date for this position will be at the beginning of the Fall 2022 semester.
