With more than 300,000 people living in the metropolitan area, it is an active, exciting and engaging community, boasting cultural and historical events, music, festivals and entertainment.

Position Description

The Department of Psychology and Sociology at West Virginia State University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor of Psychology. The Department of Psychology and Sociology is housed within the College of Business and Social Sciences.

Responsibilities for the Tenure-Track Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor of Psychology

The candidate should have the ability to teach undergraduate courses in areas such as Introductory Psychology, Social Psychology, Sex Roles, Aging, Adjustment, Community Mental Health, and Childhood Psychopathology. The ability to teach other courses will be considered; Research Methods would be desirable. The candidate is also expected to engage in research that is publishable in peer-reviewed journals, participate in service activities, advise students, and offer online courses (in addition to in-class courses) as needed. Other duties may be assigned.

Requirements for the Tenure-Track Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor of Psychology

Candidates should preferably hold a doctoral degree in Psychology. Candidates who are ABD may be considered. Prior experience will also be considered. Employment is contingent upon a successful background check.

Salary commensurate with qualifications and experience.

This is a full-time, Tenure-Track Assistant/Associate/Full Professor position.
