Dear WVSU Student Resident,

We would like to provide students with more specific instructions regarding check-out procedures from the residence halls following President Anthony L. Jenkins message to the campus community on [March 20, 2020](#). To reiterate, all students are encouraged to frequently visit the [WVSU Coronavirus COVID-19](#) webpage for updates.

Students currently in the residence halls for spring break are required to depart to campus. In an effort to adhere to Centers for Disease Control (CD) [social distancing](#) guidelines, the Office of Housing and Residence Life will required that you coordinate with the staff the check-out process to retrieve your personal belongings from the residence halls by **Monday, March 23, 2020 by 8:00 pm**.

Students who may have extenuating circumstances that inhibit them to return home can seek an exception to temporarily reside in the residence halls. To initiate this process students must please complete the [Request to Temporarily Reside in Residence Hall](#) form. Upon your arrival you will be required to present your WVSU Student ID. To ensure your health and well-being and the safety of others, students will only be permitted to have two guests accompany them to the residence halls to retrieve personal belongings.

Dining Services will continue to provide “To-Go Meals” that will available for pick-up outside of the Goldson Dining Hall at the cashier’s stands. Brunch will be served from 10:45am – 12:15pm, and Dinner from 4:30pm – to 6:00 pm. All are encouraged to regularly visit the [campus dining](#) webpage for updates.
