

## 2019-2020 Verification Worksheet V-4 Custom Verification Group

Your 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected, by signing this form you are giving WVSU financial aid office permission to update your FAFSA with the correct information. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid office. Complete all sections of this form applicable to you. Incomplete forms or forms without the requested documentation will not be processed. Based on your answers we may need to request additional documentation.

#### **B.** High School Completion Status

Provide <u>one</u> of the following documents to indicate the student's high school completion status when the student begins college in 2019-2020:

- A copy of the student's high school diploma.
- For students who completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document.
- A copy of the student's final official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A State certificate or transcript received by a student after the student passed a State-authorized examination
  that the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma (GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other Stateauthorized examination).
- An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- For a student who was homeschooled in a State where State law requires the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- For a student who was homeschooled in a State where State law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript, or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary



 school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.

A student who is unable to obtain the documentation listed above must contact the Office of Student Financial Aid.
