

## **WVSU Accreditation History**

As we learn more about the reaffirmation of accreditation on *The Road to State's Reaffirmation 2015*, let us briefly review West Virginia State University's accreditation history.

West Virginia State University is proud of its accreditation by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools in 1927. With that act, North Central Association recognized the University, the second African-American, land-grant institution to be accredited. This early recognition of the institution's quality has led West Virginia State University to possess the longest continuous accreditation of all West Virginia's institutions of higher education in the state today.
