MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE AND

WEST VIRGINIA STATE UNIVERSITY Two Plus Two Program A.A.S. in Criminal Justice and B.S. in Criminal Justice

Purpose and Philosophy

This Memorandum of Understanding commits WVSU to accept credits earned at Southern as delineated in the Suggested Course Sequence that is part of this agreement. The two plus two concept promotes the idea that students' education experience should include a seamless transition from associate degree programs to baccalaureate degree programs. This process includes recognition of prior education efforts and hope that students will recognize the importance of continuing their education. Through this Memorandum of Understanding, students are assured of acceptance of prior college courses and are offered a plan for completing a baccalaureate degree as efficiently as possible.

Background

The cooperating colleges, Southern West Virginia Community and Technical College and West Virginia State University, bring to this liaison the following backgrounds:

Southern West Virginia Community and Technical College was founded in 1971 and is a comprehensive community college located in a rural area. From that time, the college has expanded to include facilities in Mingo, Logan, Boone, Lincoln, and Wyoming Counties. The college also provides classes at several off-campus sites and through electronic interactive classroom equipment. The college offers relevant associate degree programs and emphasizes student-oriented, transferable learning, enabling students to achieve work, career, and personal success. The college is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission.

West Virginia State University was founded in 1891 as a public, land grant, historically black college. The college has evolved into a fully accessible, racially integrated and multigenerational institution. The College is the largest institution of higher education in the Kanawha Valley and a resource center for this metropolitan area. The university provides a broad spectrum of undergraduate degree programs for residential and commuting students. The College considers itself "a living laboratory of human relations" and cherishes its unique history and commitment of providing quality education through flexible course offerings in traditional and nontraditional educations settings. The University is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission.

Operational Guidelines

The following guidelines facilitate the process described in this agreement:

- 1. The Memorandum of Understanding becomes effective as of Spring Semester 2020 and shall remain in effect until terminated by either party by giving at least (30) days prior written notice of termination to the other party.
- 2. The parties to this agreement shall review the relationship every five years to assess its effectiveness and usefulness.
- 3. The parties to this agreement shall inform the other party promptly if the curricular requirements of the relevant program change.
- 4. Both colleges will designate a contact person on their respective campuses to represent their interests and carry out the program mutually agreed upon. These representatives will meet or otherwise communicate as needed to evaluate the program and propose changes.
