West Virginia State University:

Position Description

The Department of Mathematics, Engineering, and Computer Science at West Virginia State University invites applications for a full-time Assistant Professor position in Civil Engineering starting in the Fall 2025 semester. This position is renewable annually depending on teaching performance and institutional needs. The Department offers Bachelor of Science degrees in Mathematics, Engineering, and Computer Science. The Civil Engineering program has multiple active partnerships with the local industry and is actively pursuing ABET accreditation, which is anticipated by the start of the 2025–2026 academic year.

Responsibilities for the Assistant Professor of Civil Engineering

Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate Civil Engineering courses, developing and delivering high-quality instruction, maintaining regular office hours, supporting student learning through academic advising and mentorship, and participating in departmental and university committees. Engagement in scholarly or professional activities and contributions to student recruitment and retention efforts are also encouraged. The normal teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester.

Requirements for the Assistant Professor of Civil Engineering

A Ph.D. in Civil Engineering is required. ABD candidates will also be considered (but the candidates are expected to have their Ph.D. completed before the start of the Fall 2025 semester).

Candidates with expertise in environmental or transportation engineering are especially encouraged to apply. Preference will be given to those whose Bachelor's degree is also in Civil Engineering.
