I. Call to Order

Governor Kelley called the meeting to order at 11:38 p.m.

II. Roll Call

Governor Saffore seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

VII. Policy Regarding Required Board Approval

Following Board discussion, Governor Kelley called for a motion to approve the proposed policy to be distributed for the 30-day public comment period. Governor Saffore so moved, and Governor Marcum seconded the motion. The motion carried.
