### **West Virginia State University**

Founded in 1891, West Virginia State University (WVSU) is a public-land grant institution, which was originally founded as a historically black university, but which has evolved into a fully accessible, diverse, and multi-generational institution serving approximately 2,600 students. WVSU offers 23 undergraduate and 6 graduate degrees, along with one doctoral degree. WVSU competes in athletics at the NCAA Division II level in 7 men's sports and 8 women's sports. WVSU is located in Institute, WV, a suburb of Charleston, the largest city and the capital of West Virginia. With more than 200,000 people living in the metropolitan area, it is an active, exciting and engaging community, boasting cultural and historical events, music, festivals and entertainment.

### **Position Description**

The Department of Mathematics, Engineering, and Computer Science at West Virginia State University invites applications for a full-time (non-tenure-track) Instructor of Mathematics position starting Fall 2026. This position is renewable annually, depending on teaching performance and institutional need. We are seeking candidates who have a passion for teaching and student success. The normal teaching load for an instructor is 15 credit hours per semester.

The Department offers Bachelor of Science degree programs in Computer Science, Cybersecurity, Engineering, and Mathematics, and a Master of Science degree in Computer Science.

### **Responsibilities for the Instructor of Mathematics**

The successful candidate will teach elementary mathematics and mathematics education courses, maintain regular office hours, contribute to curriculum development, and participate in department and university committees.

Successful candidates will demonstrate a commitment to high-quality undergraduate instruction, support for student success in foundational mathematics, and foster academic excellence and a supportive learning environment.

### **Requirements for the Instructor of Mathematics**

A master's degree in mathematics or a related field from an accredited institution is required. The successful candidate is expected to have teaching experience at the secondary or post-secondary levels. Though not required, the ability to teach elementary physics classes or run physics labs is a plus. The successful candidate will need to complete a background check.

### **To Apply:**

First consideration will be given to applicants who submit a (i) resume, (ii) cover letter, (iii) copy of academic transcripts, and (iv) names and email addresses or phone numbers of three professional references by April 10, 2026. The position will remain open until filled. All requested information must be submitted for your application to be considered.
