#### I. Call to Order

Mr. Kelley called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

#### II. Roll Call

The clerk called the roll. Members present were Mr. Davis, Mr. Flores, Dr. Jackson, Mr. Kelley, Mrs. McKibben, Mr. Payne, Dr. Pietruszynski, Mrs. Pitchford, and Mr. Shepherd. Members absent were Mr. Gray, Mr. Jones, and Mr. Raines.

#### III. Verification of Appropriate Notice of Public Meeting

Mr. Kelley verified the Appropriate Notice of Public Meeting.

### IV. Approval of ByLaws

Mr. Kelley noted that the revised ByLaws were sent to the Board previously and are in line with discussion held during the BOG Retreat. The purpose of the revisions is to make meetings more efficient and provide more strategic information. Mr. Kelley provided an overview of the revisions regarding the committees and Board structure. Mr. Kelley asked for a motion to approve the revised ByLaws as presented. Mrs. Pitchford so moved. Mrs. McKibben seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Mr. Kelley then provided information on three proposed amendments to the approved ByLaws. First, he requested permission to allow the General Counsel to clean up the ByLaws in terms of typographical errors and formatting. Mr. Payne so moved. Mrs. McKibben seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Next, Mr. Kelley proposed an amendment to add that there will be a vice chair of each committee. Mrs. Pitchford so moved. Dr. Pietruszynski seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Lastly, Mr. Kelley proposed to have a particular sentence added under the section on committees that indicates that all actions of the Academic Affairs Committee, Business and Finance Committee, Enrollment Management and Student Affairs Committee, and Advancement Committee shall be deemed the action of the full Board. Mrs. Pitchford so moved. Mrs. McKibben seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Mr. Kelley called for a vote on the adoption of the ByLaws as amended. Mrs. Pitchford so moved. Mrs. McKibben seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
