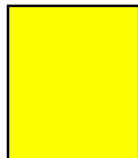


Vision 2020 Update—Academic Programs, Research Growth, Faculty Excellence and Rewards and Public Service

Overall Status



Goal V: Promote and increase university-wide public service activities, which include faculty, staff, students, alumni and partners, outreach and engagement efforts.

Strategy A: Increase the number of extension county program office locations from seven county locations to 12 by 2020 and expand the extension service area from 29 counties to 40 by 2020.

Recent Key Accomplishments

Over the past year WVSU Extension Service has expanded programming to the following new counties: Logan, McDowell, Summers, and Nicholas in the areas of Community Development (Logan, Summers, Nicholas) and Food Safety and Nutrition (McDowell).

Upcoming Activities

WVSU Extension Service will continue expanding its programming beyond the counties it currently serves, and establish three new county office locations through planning and availability of adequate resources.

Emerging Issues

Internal: Internal infrastructure and resources must be identified and procured. **External:** There is a need for quality Extension programming statewide.

Solutions

Identify West Virginia counties where the Extension Service needs match WVSUs expertise.

Identify and pursue county level partnerships for sustainable extension expansion.
