Upcoming Activities

Several academic and public service units will explore collaborative opportunities through participation in the USDA's NIFA Capacity Building Grants (April 2016 and thereafter).

Several activities are being planned by various units including CARES Day, Chemistry Olympiad, Research Symposium, Undergraduate Research Day, School Sciences Academies, etc.

Research and Public Service unit is meeting with all academic departments to discuss a coordinated system.

Federal and private external funding is being sought through grants and other proposal requests to support these activities.

Coordinated efforts among all Colleges and the Research and Public Service unit is underway to more effectively monitor and provide support for all associated activities.
